

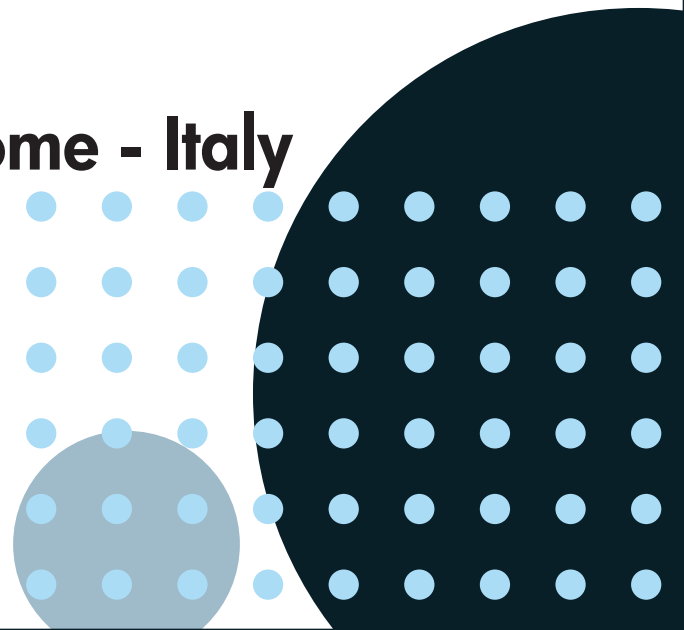

Take the underground A and get off at Anagnina stop. Then take bus 506 (direction Vanvitelli) or 507 (direction Tor Vergata-Palosci); continue on Via Berkley for about 600m.
